# PRELIMINARY REPORT PREHISTORIC PERIODS

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#### **ABSTRACT**

The prehistoric team has been surveying along the eastern part Jebel Abyad within the concession area, the northern edge of Jebel Abyad, and southern and eastern part of Jebel Merah, all within the concession area. The team has survey and registered the following;

- 1) cisterns
- 2) small caves and rockshelters of various intensity and period
- 3) open-air sites of various intensity and period
- 4) cairns
- 5) coralls
- 6) kites
- 7) in addition samples were taken from selected carins surveyed in 2009

The tendency so far which is worth noting is the following;

- 1) there has been recorded a substantial number of cairns, particularly in the Jebel Merah area.
- 2) one new kite were recorded in the southern foothills of Jebel Merah. The total number of kites within the concession area is relatively few compared to adjacent regions.
- 3) Less caves and small rockshelters were recorded in 2011, however, some of these contain lithic material similar to the survey in 2009.
- 4) Several corrals has been recorded, these are often found in fairly flat areas or where it is gently sloping in connection with minor wadies.
- 5) A few open air-sites has been recorded with scattered non-diagnostic lithics.

#### INTRODUCTION

Surveyed sites have been classified according to their nature and appearance.

- 1) cairns: this has been used on a number of various burial monuments. Many of these are severely plundered, but the significant features are that they are found along major wadis, along ridges, hills and mountain tops with good views. They may consist of small low, almost invisible circles and assemblages of stones, to larger circular well-built foundations, larger foot chains, and high large monumental cairns. Some of the cairns has been reorganised to corrals, shelters and hiding places for hunting. The cairns may consist of one or several within a short distance on a mountain top or ridge.
- **2) sites:** in this context of the survey a site number has been given in the above mentioned instances, as well as when there are no physical markers. Many of these sites can be regarded as open-air sites or workshops where lithic preparation has been undertaken. This also includes corrals, rockshelters, caves cisterns, kites and other human made structures. In general the sites are defined more clearly in the description. On a few occasions a site has also been given to a specific find, especially in cases where there is no further evidence, e.g. arrowheads or axes etc.

On the lithic material: due to the nature of the survey as we have only been collecting and recording surface finds, much of the lithic material has been patinated by wind and soil erosion.

On the classification of the lithic and pottery material: it has been classified according to major categories. There has been no effort to divide the lithic fragments into further categories, as this would not serve the aims of the project. Further, the percentages of flakes and fragments are by no means representative, as only part of the material has been picked up. It should be noted that this is a preliminary classification, which may alter significantly at a later stage. All finds (stones, flint and pottery has been assembled in one bag for each site. This bag has been marked with a site number and date. In addition the bag has a number (eg. 1-6.), which refers to the categories recorded from each site. The material has been divided into two separate categories; lithic material and pottery. There are therefore two separate lists; one includes all the material with emphasis on lithics, though with a reference to the amount of pottery, and a second list specifying the lithic material. There is a brief description of finds on each single cairn, site and shelter, though for a more detailed description one must refer to the catalogues.

The team has been surveyed between the 20.04.2011 and 28.04.2011, and has consisted of Kristina Josefson Hesse (Sweden), Torbjørn Preus Schou (Norway), Dorthe Nistad (Norway), Abdul Basset Knnawi (Syria) and Nils Anfinset (Norway) as leader of the prehistoric team. The survey was severely hampered by extremely heavy rain and the general political situation, which shortened the survey substantially.



#### III. OSL-SAMPLING

The OSL-sampling was undertaken by selecting carefully some cairns recorded in 2009 which would be suitable for dating by this method. We took samples of soil directly underneath stones connected to cairns and that were believed to be associated with the burial monument. Here the place was covered with a large cover in order to establish complete darkness. Here we used red light in order to work under the cover hammering tubes into the soil directly underneath the monument and carefully closed by strong tape, which was eventually marked with cairn number and sample number.

The following cairns and sites were sampled;

#### Carin complex 30-31:

Started with sampling cairn 31 in the south-eastern part, close to cairn 30. We dug a small bed in front of the stones, but left about 10cm in order not to disturb or pollute the sample. Then it was covered with one person under who took the samples <u>Sample 1</u>, probably best, taken to the left under the stone at c. 10 cm depth, at the 14 cm measure.

Sample 2, taken at 12 cm depth, smaller sample, and at the 30 cm measure

#### Carin 33

Tried first under one stone in the southeast, but here we did not succeed. Therefore a stone in northwest was chosen towards the squared structure. *Sample 3.* taken at c. 12 cm depth, very difficult and much stones.

#### Cairn 42

The largest of the cairns on the ridge towards the edge. Here we first considered the very edge, but the western part was chosen where there were visible edge-stones, at its closest to cairn 41

<u>Sample 4</u>, taken at 14 cm depth from the surface, taken sideways under the stone <u>Sample 5</u>, taken at 20 cm depth from the surface, straight in under the stone. The sample has a possible contamination.

#### Cairn 13

This is the largest cairn in the complex. Sample taken in the edge stones in the southeastern part of the cairn where the stones were visible. Here there were also smaller stones that were removed just in front of the large edge stones.

<u>Sample 6</u>, taken at 26 cm depth from the surface, taken sideways at the left hand side of the stone.

<u>Sample 7</u>, taken at 22 cm depth from the surface, taken straight in, at the right hand side of the stone. Sample 7 is probably best

#### Cairn 21

Taken under edge stones in the western part of the cairn.

<u>Sample 8</u>, taken sideways to the left at 17 cm from the surface, right under the stone. The sample is probably small and not a priority.

<u>Sample 9</u>, taken straight in at 15 cm depth from the surface, probably a small sample, taken right under the stone in the middle

*Sample 10,* taken to the right, right under the stone at 14 cm depth from the surface. Priority sample.

#### Cairn 55

Sample taken from the north-western edge of the foot chain of the cairn. <u>Sample 11</u>, taken on the left side, straight in just under the stone, at 15 cm depth from the surface

<u>Sample 12</u>, taken on the right side of the stone, right under the stone, straight in, taken at 11 cm depth from the surface

#### Platform of cairn 55 complex

<u>Sample 13</u>, taken slightly to the right of the middle of the stone, straight in just under the stone, taken at 11 cm depth from the surface. The sample is taken 5,6m from the southeast from the corner of the platform. This corner is towards cairn 55.

#### Cairn 122

Taken in the eastern part of the foot chain towards Wadi Takara.
