Supplementary Table 1: A complete list of proteins identified with two or more peptides using MaxQuant (version 1.2.2.5) from experiments using anti-acetyl-lysine immunoprecipitation and SILAC (stable isotope labeling with amino acids in cell culture) analysis of MOLM-13 cells treated with nutlin-3 (6 µM, 6h) is provided. MOLM-13 cells treated with DMSO (control) were labeled with light isotopes of amino acids (L), and nutlin-treated cells were labeled with heavy isotopes of amino acids (H); the reported regulation of proteins in response to nutlin-3 is the **normalized** H/L ratio, given as fold induction of control. Protein identities are sorted according to their normalized H/L ratios.
